Guidance Notes: StudyPlus Continuing Student Scholarship 2021/22*

* Subject to University tuition fees remaining at their current level (October 2019).

Introduction

StudyPlus is a personal fund given to students (UG, Full Time, On Campus) for different years of study to spend on study essentials and textbooks in the University's StudyPlus online store.

Criteria - Funds

Integrated Foundation Year – Same stage full time (PTPM) students will receive £200 of funds. £100 will be available in Semester 1, with the remainder being available in Semester 2.

Year 1 (£150) – Students that have progressed on to Year 1 from Integrated Foundation Year courses and Year 1 students repeating the same stage full time (PTPM) excluding MBChB Medicine.

Year 2 (£100) – Students that have progressed on to Year 2 from Year 1 and Year 2 students repeating the same stage full time (PTPM). MBChB Medicine year 2 Students are eligible to an £80 fund.

Year 3 (£100) – Students that have progressed on to Year 3 from Year 2 and Year 3 students repeating the same stage full time (PTPM).

Year 4 (£100) – Students that have progressed on to Year 4 from Year 3 and Year 4 students repeating the same stage full time (PTPM).

Who's eligible?

Home, OI (Isle of Man and Channel Islands), EU and International undergraduate students continuing with study in academic year 2021/22 on a University of Sunderland course.

Higher Degree Apprenticeship, PGCE, Masters and PHD levels and courses delivered at our PartnersColleges, are not eligible for this scholarship.

How to apply

You do not need to apply; this Scholarship is awarded automatically to all eligible students.

How do I receive this Scholarship

If you have a live Studyplus account set up, the funds will be added after you have reenrolled for your course. If you have not accessed your account before you can do this through www.Johnsmith.co.uk/sunderland.
